Some Silicon Valley caterers and restaurateurs are stepping up to the plate to keep people from going hungry this summer. Martha's Kitchen reports that it has received commitments from Carmine Camporaso of Fratello's Ristorante, Jack Hayes of Elegant Events Catering and Peter Carlino of Entrees Unlimited to each provide enough entrees to feed more than 300 people at a future dinner service. It's a smart way for Martha's Kitchen to meet the growing need for prepared meals. With food prices skyrocketing and more people visiting the kitchen in San Jose's Washington neighborhood this year, Executive Director Edita Cruz is approaching restaurants and catering establishments to help out. "We are not asking them for a cash donation," Cruz explained. "Instead, we are asking for something they do best - food. Even as volunteers discuss the program with potential donors, countless homeless and underprivileged people will go hungry for the night."
