



VOLUNTEER FAQs

Do I need to register or can I just show up?

Each person needs to register for their shift prior to arrival. We do not accept walk-ins. Sign up on our website: www.marthas-kitchen.org/volunteer. It will prompt you to create an account and sign the waiver before scheduling a shift.

Can children volunteer?

12 and 13-year-olds can volunteer with an adult present. 14-year-olds can volunteer independently.

What is the address?

Where do I park?

- For our Willow Street location, please park in the parking lot or on the street.
- For our Story Road location, please view the attached map in your volunteer reservation. Do not leave valuables or visible items in your car.

Can I fulfill court related hours?

No, Martha's Kitchen does not verify court-ordered or court related hours.

What if I need to cancel my shift?

We understand that life happens. Please unregister from shifts as soon as possible. Repeated no-shows will result in the removal of future shifts.

3. Select "Leave Opportunity" to cancel your shift.
